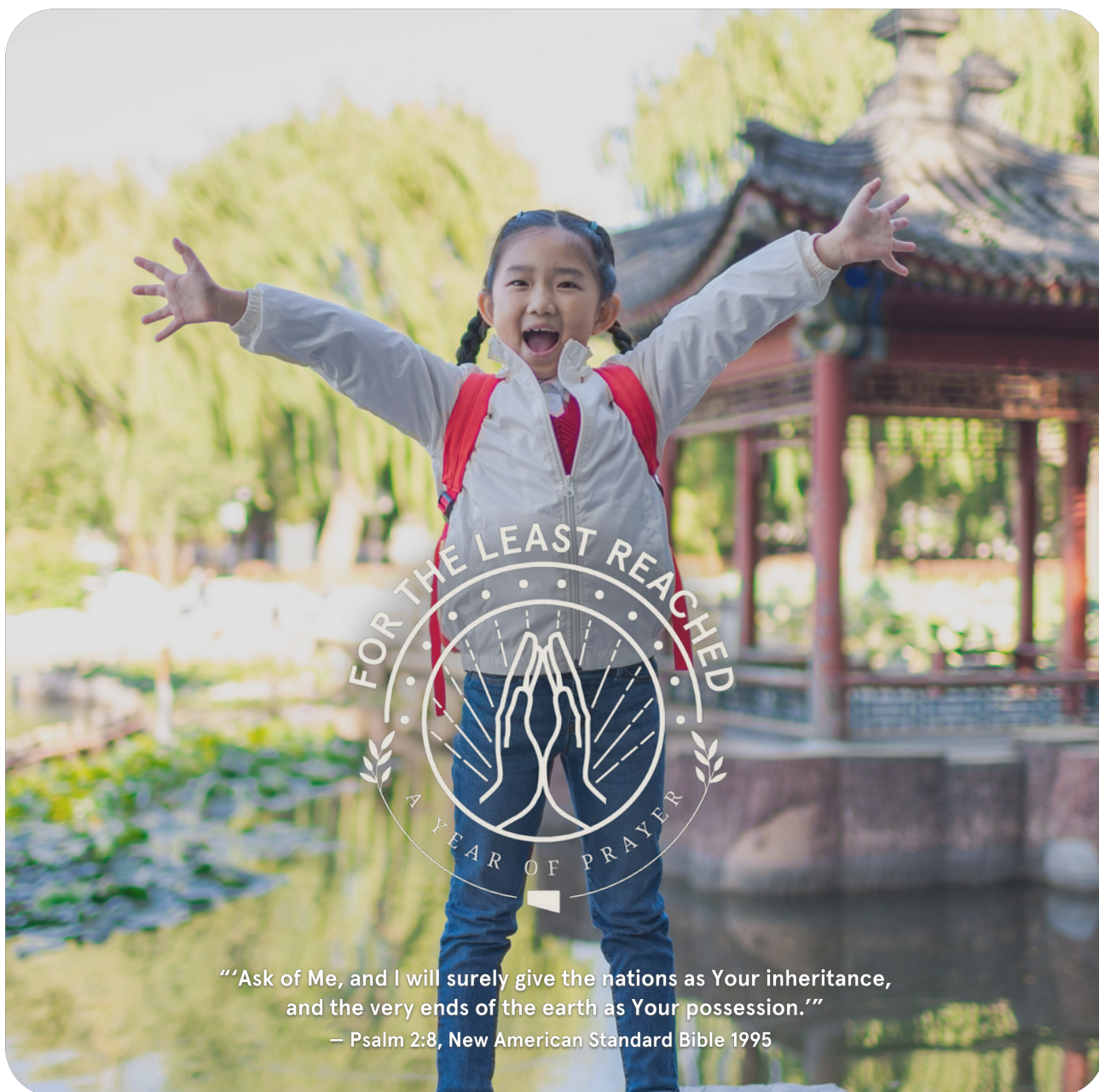


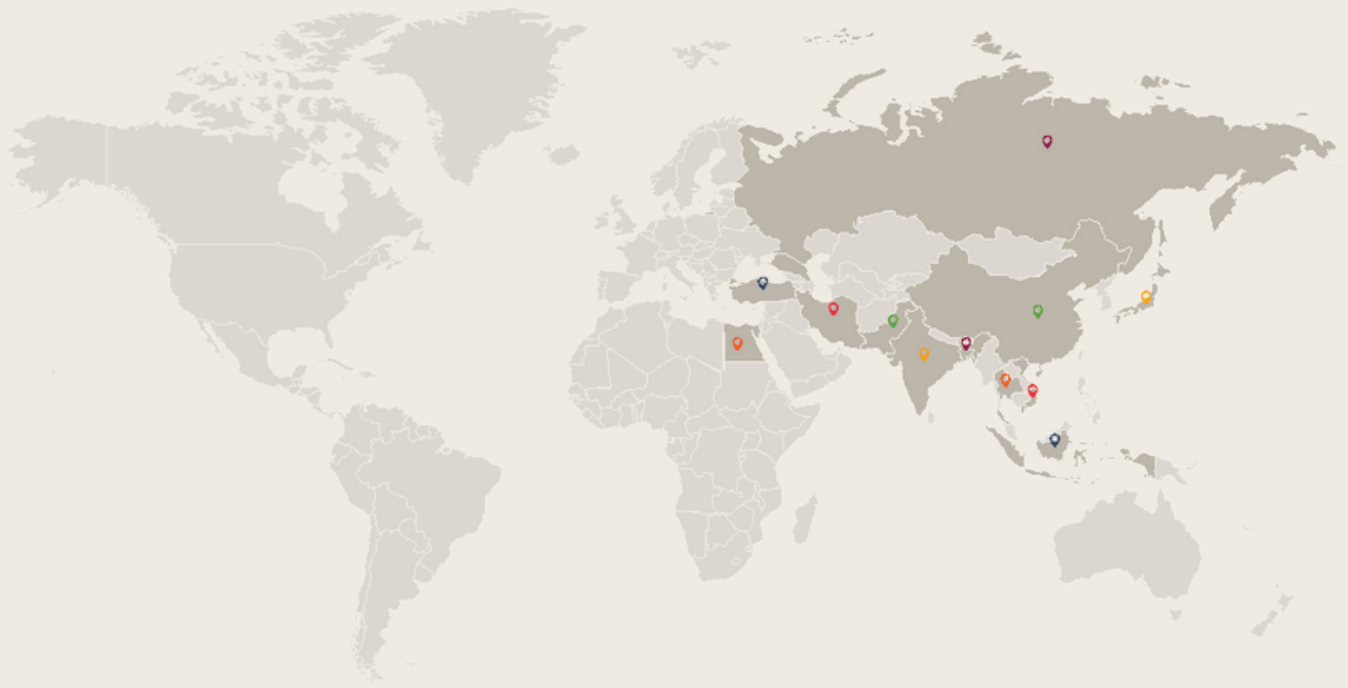

Using this handy family guide, we will travel to a faraway country every month, learn about its people and culture and pray for them. We will focus on a different least-reached country in every guide. There are 12 family guides covering 12 countries this year—one for every month.

Why do we call these countries “least reached”? Many of the people in these countries have never heard about Jesus, or it’s difficult for them to hear about Him. Even though you won’t get on a plane to each country, when you pray, you join our adventure—our mission to make a difference in the lives of the people in each country.

The best part is you’ll always know what to pray for. This family guide gives you a prayer request for every day of the week. Moms, dads and kids everywhere will be praying for the same thing together too. Let’s get started by learning about this month’s country.

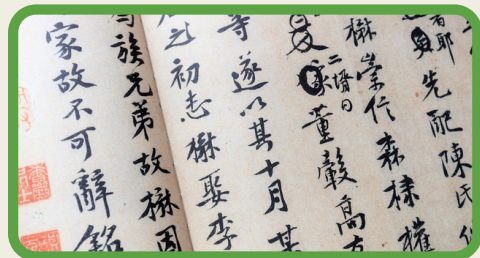

The Great Wall stretches over 13,000 miles across China. That is more than four times the driving distance from Los Angeles to New York City.



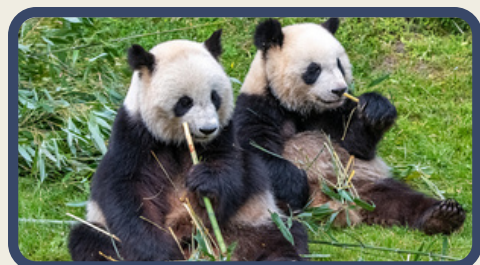
The Chinese language is the oldest written language still in use in the world. Try tracing a Bible verse in Chinese in this month's guide!



In China the color red symbolizes happiness. That's why red is used in so many celebrations and festival decorations.

Every single giant panda in the whole world belongs to China. Have you ever seen a giant panda?

Ready to pray for the people of China?

At Jesus Film Project®, we're working hard to translate the *JESUS* film into thousands of languages for people around the world. Our hope and prayer is that people everywhere can get the Bible and other Christian materials in a language they can understand. It's even better when people hear about Jesus in what we call their "heart language." Heart language means the language a person learned as a child. Your heart language is the language you know best.

What is your heart language? Do you speak any other languages? Do you know people who speak more than one language?



I'd like you to watch a few minutes of [JESUS in Mandarin](#), the language many speak in China (if you understand Mandarin, choose another language that you don't know). You can scan the QR code to see this on your mobile device.

This is what many people experience when they watch a movie in a language they can't understand.

Did you watch it? And could you understand what was being said? I can't. I do not speak Mandarin. Now, if you watch *JESUS* in English, or in your heart language, can you understand it? That's why at Jesus Film Project, we work so hard to get films like *JESUS* recorded into more languages. We want everyone to have a chance to see and hear the story of Jesus in a language they can really understand. As of today, we have translated the movie into more than 2,100 languages.

WEEK 1 REQUESTS



"The Father has loved us so much! He loved us so much that we are called children of God. And we really are His children. ..."

— 1 John 3:1, International Children's Bible



☐ Day 1

The country of China has hundreds of groups of people who are different from each other. The groups don't always get along because things happened in the past that caused hurt feelings between them. Pray that the Christians among them will bring God's peace to the local people so that everyone can be kind to one another. Pray that the people of China will experience God's love.

☐ Day 2

There are some places in China where Christians are not able to gather together as the family of God. Pray that they find safe places to meet, and that Jesus' love and truth will keep spreading in their neighborhoods.

☐ Day 3

In China there are many small people groups living in places that are difficult to reach. It takes a lot of effort to reach these faraway places, and because of that many of these people have not yet heard about Jesus. Ask God to give Christian churches in China compassion and faith to keep sharing His love with these people groups. Someone must tell them so that they, too, can know there's a loving God who wants to be their friend.

☐ Day 4

Pray for the many people of China who have not yet decided to put their trust in Jesus. His truth is very different and far more wonderful than anything they have ever known. Pray that they would worship Him and no one else.

☐ Day 5

Every country has people who are homeless, poor, lonely, sick or disabled. These people have many needs but don't always receive help. The Bible shows us how Jesus drew near to people like these, and He loved them and met their needs. Pray that followers of Jesus in China would show love and care for needy people, and become regular helpers for them. Pray that needy people would see the love of Jesus in these helpers and want to follow Him too.

☐ Day 6

Taking time to thank God is an important part of prayer. We show God how grateful we are when we spend time telling Him what we are thankful for. Let's pray that the Christians in China would be thankful to God as these verses describe.

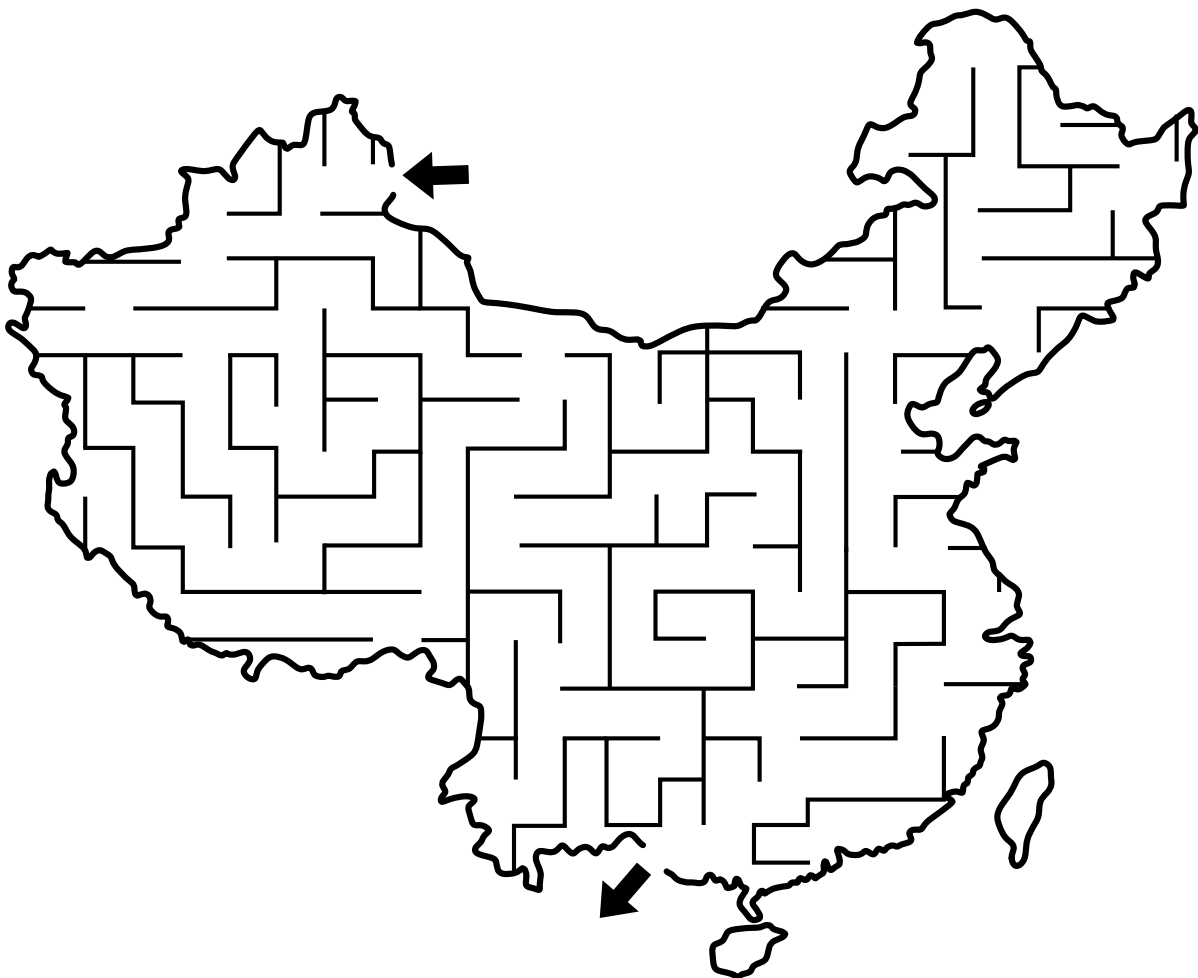

☐ Day 7

Just like children in every country, children in China know that even though they try to be good, they don't always make the right choice. Pray that God will give them a heart that wants to know Him and a heart that knows He is nearby, even though they don't see Him. He created each one of them, He loves them and He wants to forgive them when they mess up. God sent His son, Jesus, to die for our mess-ups. Pray that many children would accept Jesus' gift of forgiveness and grow to become men and women who will lead the church someday.

WEEK 2 REQUESTS

☐ Day 8

Pray that Christians in China would find other Christians and a church that teaches about the God of the Bible. Pray that they would grow to love God and each other, and support one another as God's family.

☐ Day 9

Pray that the sick will receive proper medical care to get better. Pray that Christian doctors and nurses would treat their patients with compassion and care, as Jesus would. May they bring comfort to those who are sick or hurting, letting them know they are loved by God.

☐ Day 10

The majority of Chinese people don't believe in any god. However, there are some Jesus followers and Chinese Christian churches who are working to change that. Pray for all Chinese people to learn about Jesus and what He's done for them, so they can choose to know Him.

☐ Day 11

Christians in China sometimes face unkind treatment. Pray God will help Christians be strong when they face hard things and unkind people. Pray that their strong faith in God will show others Jesus' peace.

☐ Day 12

Did you know there are many children and young people in China who have never heard of the Bible's God or His son Jesus? In fact, many schools teach that there is no such thing as God. But we know that the God of the Bible already knows and loves them all, and that each of them needs God. Pray they would learn the truth about Him, that they would put their trust in His son Jesus and keep their faith in Him all the days of their lives.

☐ Day 13

When a person decides to trust in Jesus, they begin a new life and learn to follow His ways. He has a plan for that person's life, and sometimes that means going to a special school where they learn how to become pastors, church leaders or missionaries. Pray that these students would get the very best training possible so that they can become the best Christian leaders that they can be.

☐ Day 14

Pray for Chinese people to go to the Lord in prayer even when they face many challenges. May they discover the beautiful promise of Jesus in Matthew 11:28-30 (ICB),

"Come to Me, all of you who are tired and have heavy loads. I will give you rest. Accept My work and learn from Me. I am gentle and humble in spirit. And you will find rest for your souls. The work that I ask you to accept is easy. The load I give you to carry is not heavy."

Week 2 Activity: Trace

□ Day 15

In places where Christianity is kept secret, followers of Jesus may face difficulty. Ask God to help Christians in these places to trust and listen to Him. He will guide them on what to say. He will make them strong when their life is hard.

□ Day 16

Pray that the people of China will have the food and other important supplies they need each day. Ask God to help Christians grow in thankfulness for the way He provides for them. He wants them to know they can trust in Him even when their lives are hard.

□ Day 17

Pray that the leaders of China will want to learn about the God of the Bible and will put their faith in Him. Pray they will lead in a way that is fair and right, and best for the people of the country.

□ Day 18

Pray that Christian men and women would have healthy bodies, relationships and spiritual lives. Pray that they would remember to practice what they are learning from the Bible and be careful to resist temptations to make the wrong choices.

□ Day 19

Pray that the Chinese people who don't yet know about Jesus will learn about Him through things like TV, radio, newspapers, magazines, their computers and phones. May these connections open their eyes to the truth of His claims—that He is God's Son, that He proved His love for them, and that He is alive today and forever, inviting everyone to follow Him.

□ Day 20

Pray this for every Christian in China:

"Do not worry about anything. But pray and ask God for everything you need. And when you pray, always give thanks. And God's peace will keep your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. The peace that God gives is so great that we cannot understand it." — Philippians 4:6-7, ICB

□ Day 21

Everyone needs to know about Jesus! Pray that Christians in China would share their belief and trust in Jesus with their family, friends, neighbors and co-workers. Pray that these Christians would come alongside new believers, teaching them about their new heavenly Father and how to trust Him each day, so they too may soon share their faith with others.

WEEK 4 REQUESTS



"Then I looked, and there was a great number of people. There were so many people that no one could count them. They were from every nation, tribe, people, and language of the earth"

□ Day 22

Pray that China and all the other countries in the world will find ways to work well together, even if they sometimes disagree with each other. Pray that leaders will hear the gospel of Jesus, and that they can find the best ways to work together to make the world a better place.

□ Day 23

Being a parent is hard work. That is true in China as well. Pray that Christian moms and dads in China would ask God for wisdom in being parents. Pray they learn how to best express love to their children so that each child knows they are dearly loved.

□ Day 24

People in every country love entertainment, like television, movies, video games, and books. But some forms of entertainment aren't honoring to God. Pray that Christians in China can help create uplifting forms of entertainment. Pray that more and more people would look for entertainment that honors God.

□ Day 25

Pray for Christian men and women who have not found a husband or wife yet, that they will see being single as God's gift to them for now. He has a purpose! Pray they will patiently wait for whomever God has for them to marry, and use the time they have now to make their faith stronger by trusting Him in all things.

□ Day 26

Jesus was the very best example of how to live rightly. People were often watching Him, and they saw that He was kind, loving and wise in all that He said and did. His love and kindness toward others honored God, His Father in heaven. Pray that Christians in China would live this way too. Whether they are business people, leaders, teachers, moms, dads or kids, may their words and actions always be kind, fair and loving to everyone. By doing this, those who don't yet know Jesus may want to follow Him too.

□ Day 27

Pray that Christian gatherings in China would follow Paul's instructions from this Bible verse:

"Let the teaching of Christ live in you richly. Use all wisdom to teach and strengthen each other. Sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs with thankfulness in your hearts to God."

— Colossians 3:16, ICB

□ Day 28

Pray Christians in China would model God's plan for marriages and families. God's plan includes husbands and wives who love and care for each other, treat each other well, and put each other's needs before their own. He can empower parents to love and train their kids in the ways taught in the Bible. Let's also pray that kids would love, respect and obey their parents.

□ Day 29

There are 24 hours in each day. So if you thank God at mealtimes, pray at bedtime, and pray for the daily requests in this guide, that leaves many hours of not talking at all to our heavenly Father. But God wants us to talk to Him often and about everything, including things like your homework, your friends, your family and even your attitude. He wants you to ask Him about each decision you make. Ask God to help you, and the believers across China, to build a habit of prayer. He's waiting to hear your prayers right now.

□ Day 30

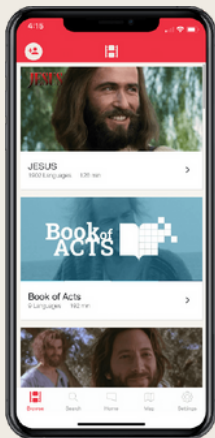

Our hope is that when we pray for China and other least-reached countries, some will feel so much compassion for China's people that they pray and pray, all day long and every day. □ Day 31

Lord Jesus, we thank You for giving us a chance to pray for China each day this month.
